

Beer Holster Pattern

Materials:

- Pleather or leather approximately 12x12 inches
- Strong thread such as leather thread or embroidery floss
- Leather punch tool and rivet/button pieces*
- Scissors
- Needle

*If you don't have a leather punch tool simply add the top loop piece to the base piece and cut out as one piece. Fold over the loop back onto the base and sew in place. You will just have to feed your belt through the loop while putting the belt on.

Steps:

Step 1: Cut out pattern pieces. Trace and cut out pieces from your leather/pleather.

Step 2: Use a leather punch tool to create button clasps on one end of the top loop piece and the top of the base piece.

Step 3: Line up the opposite end (without the buttons) of the top loop piece to the top, backside of the base piece. Ensure that the right side of the leather is facing out when the loop is pulled over and buttoned up. Then stitch together.

Step 4: Line up the front piece onto the base piece and sew both sides into place.

Step 5: Line up one end of the bottom loop piece to the bottom of the base piece and sew into place. Then line up the opposite end of the bottom loop piece to the bottom center of the front piece. You can insert a beer bottle to make sure there is enough room.

Step 6 (Optional): Blanket stitch around the edges of all of the pieces for a Western style trim.

Step 3 (Optional): Create a rivet/eyelet using the leather punch tool in the base piece to create a hole for a bottle opener keychain.

Step : (Optional): Glue a mat board or piece of cardboard to the back of the holster to provide more structure.

~To wear simply unbutton the top loop, feed the top loop through the belt you're wearing and button the top loop closed making sure that the front piece is facing out away from the body.

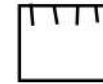
